Class Fundraising Christmas Cards

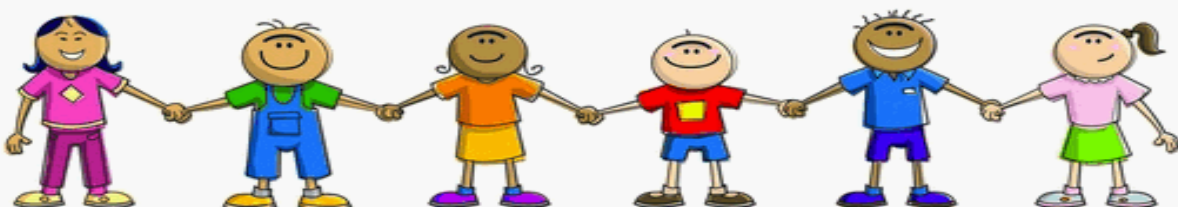
The completed Christmas card designs have now been sent off and the prototypes should be sent back to school in no longer than 2 weeks. These will be handed directly to parents once they have arrived.

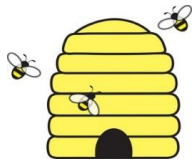
Half Term
