BIG QUESTION: Why does Easter Matter to Christians?

- 1) Think about the theme of 'new life' and connect this to Spring
 - Take photographs and/or draw things you notice in your gardens or on walks e.g. flowers, buds, blossom

2) Read and listen to the Easter story

- Act out the story
- Draw the main parts of the story in a storyboard: Jesus enters Jerusalem (Palm Sunday), Jesus is arrested, Jesus dies on the cross (Good Friday), the empty tomb (Easter Sunday), Jesus appears to Mary Magdalene and the disciples
- Add the emotions of Jesus' followers to the storyboard e.g. Good Friday = sad, Jesus appears to Mary and disciples = happy, overjoyed
- 3) Connect the ideas of eggs with new life and Jesus' resurrection and heaven
 - Make an Easter garden

4) Find out how churches celebrate Holy Week (Palm Sunday, Good Friday, Easter Sunday

- Design your own Easter egg
