Dear Parents,

We have had a brilliant start to term 4! The children have been busy building a yellow brick road inspired by our class book, turning pancakes into clocks, and learning all about light!

In literacy, we will be exploring non-chronological reports! The children will be taught how to structure their writing, to include titles and subtitles, and will be editing their work using thesaurus'. Our class book for this term is 'The Wonderful Wizard of Oz' - if you wish, you can get the book for your child to read and follow along with in class. I'm also excited to share the 2020 World Book day with the children on Thursday 5th March - our author focus this year is Roald Dahl (if your children wish to dress as a character they are welcome to).

In maths, I am teaching the children to tell the time. We have already learnt roman numerals to 12, and have been looking at the key parts of a clock face, and how they work. Every day I'm getting the children to look at the class clock and tell the time. To support them in their journey you too could encourage your children to tell the time throughout the day.

Topic & Science

In science this term we are moving onto light, learning about where it comes from, how objects emit light, and how we are able to see light. I have lots of engaging and fun practical activities planned, to engage the children in the topic.

This term we also have our second week of assessments. Assessment week will be taking place from Monday 9th March - we will be supporting the children through this week, and I will discuss how your children are doing at our parents evening this term.
