### **COMMUNICATION AND LANGUAGE**

- Re-tell the story to an adult or sibling
- How would you describe the giant?
- Make your own character stick puppets to re-enact the story


# PERSONAL, SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL DEVELOPMENT

- Think about Jack and the giant do you feel their actions were good or bad?
- Describe a time where you have done something kind for a member of your family
- With an adult or sibling, build a tall beanstalk using blocks (or similar).
   Take it in turns to add one block at a time before it falls over!

# MATHS - NUMBERS, SHAPES, SPACE AND MEASURE

- The beanstalk was very tall. Can you find 5 things in your house that are taller than you and 5 things that are shorter than you?
- Look for leaves while out walking and then order them by size
- Retrieve magic beans (jelly beans)
  from a bowl of rice using tweezers.
   Count each bean as you pick it up. Sort
  the beans by colour and identify which
  colour group has the "most" and "least"

## PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT
