
Class book: Billionaire boy Class 2 Term 4 2020/21 Spring Term 2021



For the rest of this term we will be continuing with our maths and literacy journeys, supporting children in these areas. For our afternoon sessions, there will be more focus on supporting the children's return to school through group and cooperative work, circle time, and overall emotional support.

As young **athletes** the children will be focusing on gymnastics with Mrs Ballard. They will be working together, supporting each other, and developing their strength, balance, and coordination.

As **Geographers** the children will be working together to explore natural geographic features. Together we will undertake practical investigations.

We will be finishing the term celebrating Easter, with a host of fun Easter activities.

ENGLISH

In English we will continue to focus on poetry, exploring a variety of different styles of poetry, and being creative in writing our own poems.

We will then be moving onto story writing again, using out class book 'Billionaire boy' as our focus.

We will also be using our class book for our daily guided reading.

MATHEMATICS

In Maths this term we will be focusing on the following areas:

Year 3

- Multiplication and division
- Measuring money
- Adding and subtracting money

Year 4

- Division using written methods.
- Identifying and comparing angles.

Geography

Physical geography: We will be looking at settlements and land use, through practical sessions the children will understand how river, volcanoes, earthquakes and other physical features come to be.

PE

The children will be focusing on shared physical games to help them develop cooperative skills, and will be working with Mrs Ballard to improve their fitness and balance in gymnastics

RE

We will be taking part in an RE art competition, and the children will be learning about Easter traditions, and why Christians celebrate Easter. We will also be having some Easter fun during the last week of term.

PSHE

For PSHE the children will be spending lots of time-sharing in circle discussion, working together, and considering what makes a good friend. This is especially important as the children have had such a prolonged period of time away from school.

Continue to learn how to work well together in groups, to use our individual strengths to support each other while creating excellent pieces of work. Working collaboratively will teach the children about themselves and about each other, and will be an important skill they can carry forwards.
