SCHOOL LUNCHES

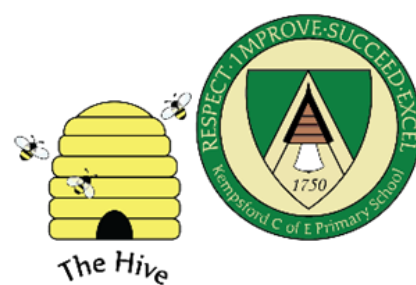
Remember all reception, year 1 and year 2 children can order a free meal every day. The cost for children in pre-school and KS2 is £2.34 per meal. Please remember all meals are cooked onsite by CaterLink. We actively encourage parents to book meals in advance & ideally by midday on Thursday of the week before using ParentPay.

BREAKFAST CLUB
