BIG QUESTION: Why is Easter Special to Christians?

1) Read and listen to the Easter Story

- Act out the story
- Draw the main parts of the story (Palm Sunday, Jesus' arrest, Good Friday, Easter Sunday)

2) Think about the importance of the cross as a symbol for Christians.

- Make crosses out of anything! e.g. Lego, craft materials, natural materials
- Make hot cross cakes or biscuits using marzipan or icing for the cross. Feel free to try buns but these are tricky!

3) Think about how Christians believe Jesus came alive again. Link this to signs of new life in Spring

- Make an Easter garden
