Eg

Characters: Alice, a dog, a witch, a cat, a bird (Yep, she's going to join Room on a Broom!!!)

Setting: A forest and a lake

4.A cat has stolen her favourite bird!!

3.Alice follows and finds a witch crying-broken broom

5.Alice and the dog fix the broom

2. Alice has to shrink to get through the door

6.They find the cat

1.Alice falls down the rabbit hole
She sees the dog running through the door

7.The bird is saved!
