If you were a werewolf, what would you look like? Draw a picture of yourself as a werewolf, as if you too were in the book.

Literacy

Diary entry – Imagine you're Ulf, write yourself a diary entry from his perspective. Maybe you've just extracted the Redback's venom, or maybe you're on another adventure?!
