

Personal and social development

- 1. Look after your favourite toy for the day. Make sure it is safe and warm.
- 2. How did Kipper feel when he lost sock thing? How did sock thing feel? What would you do to help Kipper and sock thing?

Communication and Language

- 1. Try retelling the story of Kipper using the YouTube video but without any sound.
- 2. Pretend you are Kipper from the story. Use your own toys and a toybox to act out the story.
- 3. Have an adventure with your toys.

Physical Development

- 1. Can you move like different toys?
- 2. Use outside toys to move around e.g. scooters, skateboards
- 3. Make up a game to play with your favourite toy.
- 4. Create a train track or road and use trains or cars along these.

Literacy

- 1. Draw a story map for *Kipper's Toybox*
- 2. What toys would you keep in a toybox? Draw your toybox and toys and try and label them.
- 3. Design and label a new toy.
- 4. Write a book about toys using the sentence starter *This is a*
