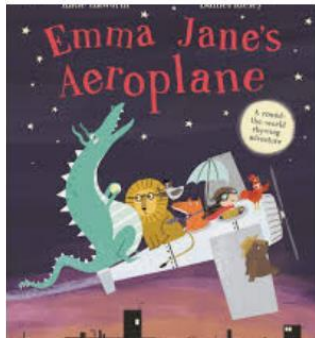
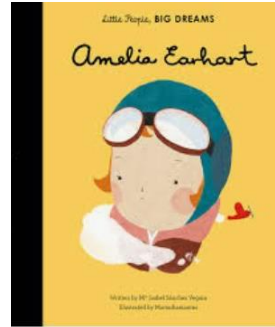


Up and away!

Key Areas of Learning



As **Design Technologists** we will be making our own aeroplanes and making working cars in pairs. We will evaluate how we made them and how effective they are.

As **Scientists** we will be using the aeroplanes and cars we have made to explore forces and how they work. With the planes we will explore how we can change how far or quickly they move and we will be exploring friction with the cars, testing how they move on different surfaces.

As **Historians** we will use the timelines we have created about different transports to help us compare how transport has developed over time. We will also consider what we think transport could look like in the future and work in small groups to create a new futuristic mode of transport.

ENGLISH

In English we will be starting by completing our Instructions unit with our Golden Write.

For the remaining weeks of this term, we will be using the book Emma Jane's Aeroplane to explore rhyming words and support us in creating our own poetry!

MATHEMATICS

In Maths lessons we will be focusing on the following areas:

Year 1 – Addition and subtraction

Year 2 – Multiplication and division (times tables facts)

RE

We will be planning and completing artwork for the Diocese Art competition this term.

PSHE

We will be doing weekly Circle Times exploring friendships, positive and negative relationships and developing good self-esteem.

PE

In PE we will be focussing on gymnastics and dance. We will also be doing timed team challenges with the aim of improving the time each week and reflecting on what went well and what needs improvement.

COMPUTING

In Computing we will be taking turns to help type up the instructions that we have written.

MUSIC

As musicians we will be listening and appraising a song called 'It's OK, please just say' which focuses on mental health and wellbeing. We will explore finding a rhythm and working in small groups
