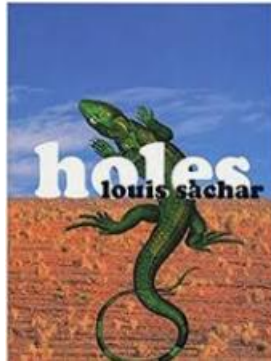

Key Areas of Learning

As **Scientists** we will identify and explain the function of the major organs in the body. We will be able to locate their position and discuss which body systems they belong, and their part in respiration and digestion

As **Design Technologists** we will be exploring textiles. We will be using felt and cotton fabrics to create a unique piece of craft. We will be measuring and cutting the fabric, and then using running stitch to attach additional features. Some children will also use blanket stitch to attach fabrics together.

As **Artists** we will be focusing on pencil drawing. We will be looking at animals and using pencil and paper to create images. Children will focus on sketching and shading.

As **Geographers** we will study Ancient Maya. We will be looking at their monetary system, their culture and building. We will also be comparing Ancient Maya to our world today.

ENGLISH

In English we will be studying fiction and poetry.

We will be exploring different poetic form, their structure and we will be creating our own anthology of poems of the forms we have enjoyed the most.

Our second text type is short stories. We will be looking at the nature of short stories, the structure they take and we will be creating our own 100 word stories.

MATHEMATICS

In Maths lessons we will be focusing on the following areas:

RE

In RE we will be discussing the question 'What do Christians believe Jesus did to 'save' people?' This will be explored through the Easter story.

COMPUTING

In Computing we will be creating and moving our own characters using the Stop Motion Animation application to develop a short castle and dragon film. We will also import our background designs that were created using Photo Story 3.

PSHE

In PSHE we will considering friendships and how we interact with each other. We will look at what makes a good friend and why this is important. Alongside this, we will be looking at how to can listen well to others.

MUSIC

As musicians, we will be learning to appreciate music from other cultures. Through the BBC Teach website, we will be looking at an aboriginal song, learning its origins, and then learning the words and melody.

PE

In PE we will be focussing on team building activities and then starting to exploring gymnastics.

MFL

In French, we will be exploring how to ask 'What would you like?' and looking at answers to this through a variety of topics.

Be taking part in a variety of team building exercise during PE and working collaboratively during afternoon session for our topic based subjects.
