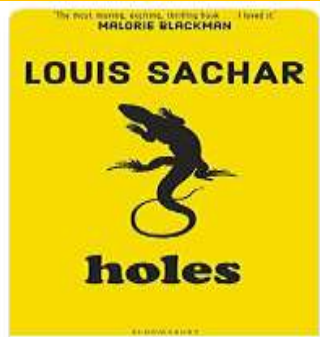

Key Areas of Learning

ENGLISH

MATHEMATICS

In Mathematics Year 6 will be focusing on reasoning and arithmetic which year 5 will continue their Can Do journey along with working on multiplication daily and take part in consolidation sessions before moving on in their sequence of lessons.

PSHE

In PSHE we will be looking wider world and how we fit into the community while focusing on Money and work.

PE

In PE we will be working on net games and hoping to produce Wimbledon's next champion.

SCIENCE

In Science we will be looking at using light to create effect and production. We will be doing this work in the art as it's a very practical topic.

MUSIC

Last term we looked at ballads, namely songs by Adele. Next term we will be looking at rap.
