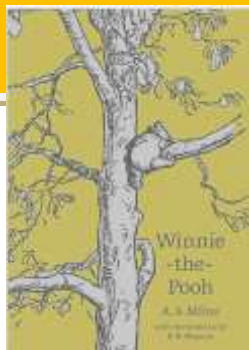


Stories of friendship

Key Areas of Learning

As **Scientists**, we will be focusing on living things and their habitats, which will include creating microhabitats for minibeasts and considering what they need to help them survive. We will design and create our own bug hotels to help attract and care for minibeasts in our back garden area. We will also learn about different types of habitat and how they are suited to different animals needs.

As **Design Technologists**, we will be learning about where fruit and vegetables come from and how they grow. We will then use healthy eating principles to create a list of ingredients for a fruit salad and then create an algorithm/recipe for how to make it. We will then follow the algorithm we have created to make our fruit salad using knife skills and weighing skills.

As **Geographers**, we will be undertaking research to compare two different places, Kempston and Kenya. We will explore different human and physical features of both places to find out what similarities and differences there are between them. We will use geographical language to describe the places such as names of rivers and land features.

ENGLISH

In our writing, we will be exploring adventure stories by writing a new adventure story including Winnie the Pooh.

Later in the term, we will do some writing challenges to help us practice the skills we have been learning this year.

For Guided Reading, we will be using the book hook to make predictions, inferences and answer questions from the text.

MATHEMATICS

In Maths lessons, we will be focusing on the following areas:

Year 1 – Multiplication and Division

Measurement

Year 2 – Money

Length and mass

Each year group will also be practicing and revisiting skills previously learned this year.

RE

In RE we will be exploring the question 'What makes some places sacred to believers?'

Our value that we will be exploring this term is Friendship.

PSHE

We will be celebrating School Diversity week this term. We will also be learning about how humans grow and change, understanding differences between ourselves and others and challenging gender stereotypes. *More information on content to follow*

In Computing, we will be continuing our learning about creating animations using programming software.
