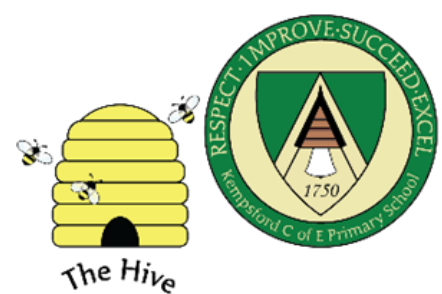


Kempsford Church of England Primary School

The end of a short but busy term.

The whole school had an assembly led by Midland Air Ambulance where they heard about all the fantastic work the charity do. Class 3 had a mission support skill session which teaches basic CPR skills and how to control severe bleeding wounds.



The following week we welcomed Gloucestershire Cricket Foundation in to lead a Cricket session for each of our classes.



Class 3 went to SkillZONE where they visited the interactive life skills village and learned how to keep themselves safe at home and in their community. They experienced what a police custody cell was like, worked out how best to keep safe in a dark alley and a builders yard. They also had workshops on steps to support their wellbeing and also be safe on the internet.

We also had a visit from REEL (Angling Trust) which was a thoroughly enjoyable session in which children discussed water safety and also experienced catching fish in the hall.



We have finished the term with a fantastic whole school PE day focused on Perseverance.

Children worked in mixed aged teams to gain points for their Houses. They not only showed great Perseverance but many other values, such as respect and care and compassion. We may have got a little muddy but it was a day enjoyed by all.

Next term we have an exciting visit from Birmingham University. They will be bringing with them some racing cars and a 3D Robot printer. Children will hopefully have the opportunity to engage in activities to build a basic car, look at different wind turbine designs and also discuss careers. I personally am looking forward to this day – it sounds very exciting.

We are also inviting parents into school to support children with reading for pleasure. This is time where you can enjoy a book with your child. There will also be an opportunity to buy refreshments.
