

## Mathematics

In maths we will be learning to measure lengths and heights and then measure mass, capacity and temperatures. We will also cover topics such as place value within 100, composition of 11 to 15 as 10 and a bit, learning the position of numbers 11 to 15 on the number line, read, write and interpret equations using  $+$ ,  $=$ , subtracting within 20 and focus on the composition of 20.

## Values – Perseverance

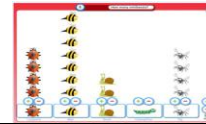
Our value this term is Perseverance. This means never giving up, even when things get tough or challenging. It is the choice to keep trying, working, and practicing toward a goal, rather than quitting when faced with mistakes or difficulties. It's about having the "grit" to push through, like finishing a puzzle or



learning a new skill.

## Computing

This term our computing is all about pictograms. We will be learning to count and compare objects using tally charts, enter data into a chart and create our own pictograms. We will also be learning to select objects by an attribute and make comparisons and recognise that people can be described by attributes.



## Literacy

First, we will be using the text 'The Building Boy' by Ross Montgomery and David Litchfield. We will learn what an architect does and then we will write our own adventure story about building something exciting with Grandma. We will then use the text 'The Day the Crayons Quit' by Oliver Jeffers. We will be learning how to investigate the structure and main features of persuasive writing and to write effective sentences for a persuasive letter.

## Science

In science, we will be learning the different stages of the human life cycle, which offspring comes from which parent animals, observe and measure growth in humans. We will also learn to recognise the importance of exercise and personal hygiene.

## PSHE



Our Happy Mind lessons focus on 'Relate' and our module is all about understanding how to have good relationships with others and learning about our differences and how they can help us. We will also learn about health education which focuses on healthy eating, physical activity, dental hygiene, sun safety and playing and learning together.

## History

In history we will be learning how schools have changed over time, investigate what schools were like in the 1900's, compare a modern classroom with a classroom from 100 years ago, and express a personal response to history.

## RE

In RE we will be learning about how Christian, Muslim and Hindu stories can express worldviews. Biblical stories emphasize themes of forgiveness and mercy. Muslim poems and tales of the prophets emphasize love for Allah and moral conduct. Hindu stories focus on teaching moral values and devotion through engaging narratives of gods, heroes, and animals.

## DT

In DT we will describe how chairs are made for different users and purposes. Explain how design briefs and design criteria help when making a new product and understand and use the vocabulary of strong, weak, stiff and flexible. We will make a stable chair structure for a bear and select suitable materials and join them securely. Then evaluate our product against the design criteria.
