<p><b>Literacy</b></p> <p>Find a poem or short story you like. Write 5 questions about the text that you could ask a friend to answer. Try to include retrieval and inference questions.</p>	<p><b>Maths</b></p> <p>Look around your house and find 5 items. Note down how they are measured. Are they in grams, litres, cm etc? Can you convert the measurement from either metric to imperial or vice versa?</p>	<p><b>PE - Athletics</b></p> <p>Create your own challenge course and time yourself to see how quickly you can complete it. Try to include lots of athletic skills such as jumping, throwing and sprinting.</p>
<p><b>History</b></p> <p>Create a poster about the Sikh Empire. Include key facts that we have learnt in class such as who the leader is, how the Empire began and why it ended.</p>	<p><b>Science</b></p> <p>Find an item in your house that includes a circuit. Draw the circuit thinking about the different elements it would include, for example, switches, lights, etc.</p>	<p><b>Computing</b></p> <p>Design a robot that could be coded using a microbit. Think about what you would like the robot to do and the steps you would need to code it.</p>
